Begali is a small family-run company with about eight hectares of vineyards spread among the hills near Cengia, a village that takes its name from the local rocks in the heart of Valpolicella. In the hilly area called Monte Ca 'Bianca there is part of the vineyards where the grapes are selected for the production of one of their Amarone crus. Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella and Molinara are the autochthonous grapes that contribute to the production of the company's wines; other vines are used in limited quantities.

The processing, both in the countryside and in the cellar, is immaculately kept: the goal is the constant search for the highest quality.

Founded by Giordano Begali towards the end of World War II, the company passed to his son Lorenzo and his wife Adriana.

The tradition continues now with the entry of the sons Giordano and Tiliana.
