The history of the Dornach Estate begins about 5,000 years ago, the period in which the first settlements found in Dornach date back.

The first mention of the "Dornachhof" (Dornach farm) dates back to 1288 by Count Mainardo II, Count of Tyrol and Duke of Carinthia (founder of Tyrol).

In 1836 Anton von Gelmini zu Kreuzhof bought Dornach. It will be his son Max, later, to give the appearance that still characterizes the estate, with the individual terraced vineyards divided by the characteristic dry stone walls.

The last descendants of the Hausmann family (married to the Gelmini zu Kreuzhof family), three sisters, inherit Dornach in 1980 and after years of commitment and dedication complete the restoration of the estate.

Today we, the heirs of the Von Hausmann and Von Gelmini families, take care of the estate and the vineyards.

Since 2008, the year of Patrick's entry into the company, he begins the conversion to organic and the development of agricultural production according to the principles of biodynamic agriculture.

Biodynamic agriculture is experienced as something much deeper than a mere agricultural technique. For Patrick and his wife Karoline it represents a process of development, which passes from the vineyards, to the vegetable gardens, to the animals, up to us.
